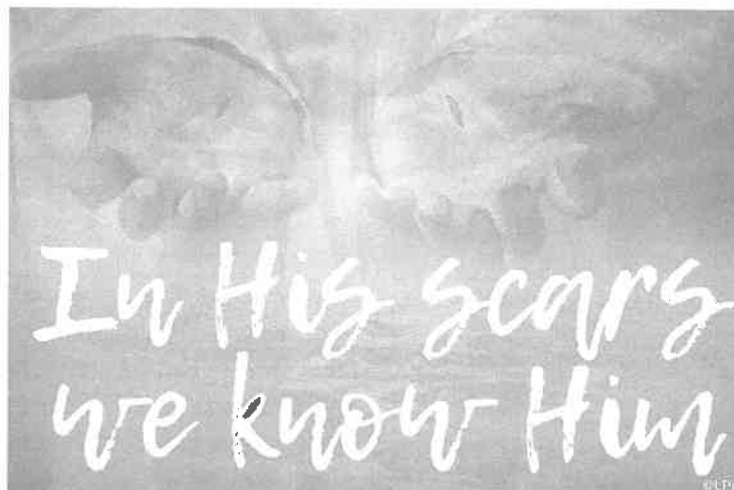
### The sweetness of Jesus:
