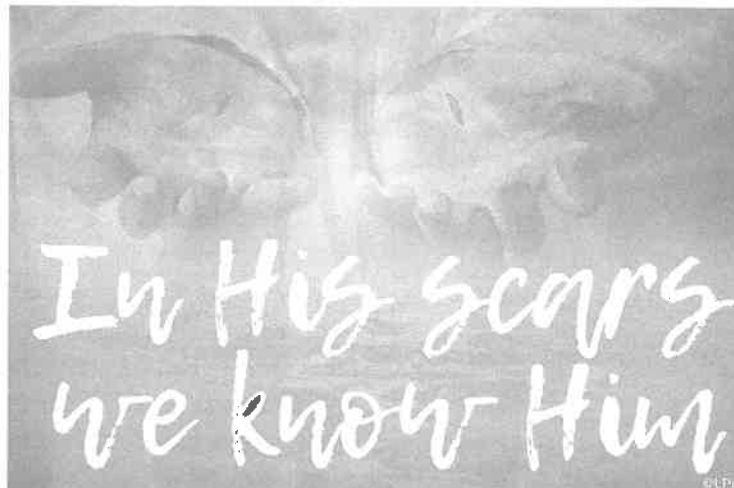
The sweetness of Jesus:
